 - Even if you go to the same college

- › Federal student loans





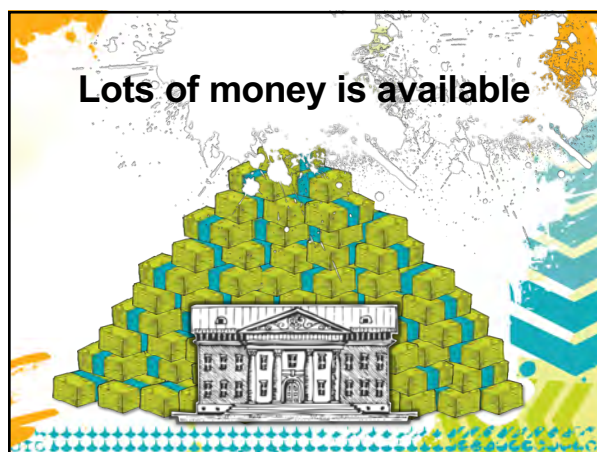
